

DOCUMENT UPLOADS



APPLICATION REVISION

COMPLETENESS



Subgrantee applicants will be given the opportunity to revise materials if fundamental issues are flagged that prevent the application from moving to the next stage of review

• Subgrantee applicants will be notified if an application's materials are flagged as insufficient.

SCORE VALIDATION



Subgrantee applicants will be given the opportunity to revise materials in the Scoring Criteria section (Section 3) if WBO identifies discrepancies

- Subgrantee applicants will be notified if an application's calculated score does not align with the submitted materials.
- Revision requests will be sent out for all applications at the same time.
- Subgrantee applicants should expect to have five (5) business days to resubmit requested materials.

NON-SCORED MATERIALS



Subgrantee applicants will be given the opportunity to revise all other sections if WBO identifies issues during the eligibility review

- Subgrantee applicants will be notified if an application's non-scored materials are insufficient and require revision.
- Subgrantee applicants should expect to have seven (7) business days to resubmit requested materials.
